Motion made by McCollum, seconded by Birkel, to sign the letter of intent. All in favor, motion carried. Instructed David to get on the town board agenda.

Schoenike explained the issue with the land use in the Four Winds Subdivision. Dave Guckenburger expressed his concerns regarding the situation.
